According to information from the United Nation, Sindhupalchock is one of the worst hit districts, where 95 percent of all housing has been destroyed. Therefore, VINCI has decided to donate money to this area through three different NGOs, of which the Red Cross is one. For each Crown the employees donate VINCI will donate just as much. Considering the fact that we

have close to 200 000 employees in the group it should be able to amount to quite a lot.
